Your existing experience of at least four to five years in asset management within a large commercial or local government organisation will have honed your professional skills in asset management planning and influencing others.

Being an expert in your field, you are able to establish excellent contacts throughout the organisation, especially with asset planners, asset managers, information services and finance groups while relating to and directing specialist technical and business consultants.

For this role, knowledge of local authority business structures is essential, as is a tertiary qualification in a related field e.g. engineering, financial management, or resource management.
