Commencing in 2023, Accounting & Finance will no longer be published in hard copy form. Instead, the journal will convert to publishing in an on-line format. This is consistent with many other journals that are converting to an on-line format only, including 620 Wiley journals.

Moving online-only reduces the environmental impact of journals, removing the carbon created from paper production, printing, and shipping physical copies. Between 2020 and 2022 alone Wiley have saved 715 tons of CO2 by reducing print across the Wiley portfolio by 650,000 copies.

The journal will continue to be available via the website and via the new Wiley Online Library App. The app, available on iOS and Android, which allows users to download full issues of A & F and read on the go.

However, we know that in some circumstances, readers or contributors may wish to have a print copy for their personal use. As such, Wiley will offer Member Direct Print-on-Demand (MD POD) and Print-on-Demand (POD) services for A & F

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## Emergency E-Learning: A Study on the effects of the transition to online learning

The current COVID-19 restrictions in place for 2020 and 2021 are being investigated in terms of the changing environment academics were forced into due to stay at home orders, where they entered into emergency e-learning, from home.

The effects of emergency e-learning on academics' workloads, job satisfaction and motivation, as well as overall wellbeing have yet to be investigated and reported. It is hoped this survey will shed some light on the challenges and opportunities accounting and finance academics faced during lockdown teaching.
