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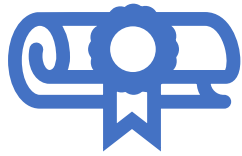
Let us imagine

...

.... the purpose of a doctoral inquiry is systematic enquiry made public (Lee & Kamler, 2008).

- Addressing readers outside of your supervisors and examiners
- Acquiring sufficient distance to the text to strategically decide on how to produce text.

Suggestion #1

Peer review

- student peers work together and with more experienced researchers and writing specialists
 - to develop expertise in different aspects of research writing
 - to enter explicitly into a network of peer relations

Suggestion #2:

Macro-micro exercise

- Relationship of parts to whole in the larger thesis text
- Draw a conceptual map of dissertation text
- Develop logical links and arguments between ideas in each chapter
